Presentation to the Board:

- **Mr. Keith Schenker**, Principal of the High School, discussed the criteria a student must achieve to be designated as an “AP Scholar.” The designation is in recognition of a student’s exceptional achievements on their Advanced Placement (AP) examinations. Together with **Ms. Sheryl Goodine**, Assistant Principal and Superintendent **Dr. Laurence Aronstein**, **Mr. Schenker** congratulated the thirty-nine students enrolled in the Advanced Placement program who have earned the coveted “AP Scholar” designation from the College Board.
